

Continuing Education Requirement

The Office of Professional Programs, an agency of the Supreme Court of the State of Arkansas, administers the continuing education (CE) requirement for Arkansas Certified Court Reporters.

Certified Court Reporters in Arkansas are required to obtain 30 hours of approved CE every three years. The three year period, also called the “reporting period”, begins on January 1 and concludes on December 31 of each three year period.

Your attention is drawn to additional documents on this website titled “Section 10 - Continuing Education Requirement” and “Continuing Education Categories and Credits”.

The Office of Professional Programs will inform all newly certified court reporters of this requirement, and will provide a report twice a year advising each court reporter of his or her CE status.
